she is working in CoopTech Hub where she supports the creation of new cooperatives from various industries. Currently, she is working on developing know-how to establish the first citizen-based energy cooperatives in Poland.

She is a certified coach specializing in the area of leadership and cooperation for social change. As part of her training and coaching activities, she conducted workshops, incl. on eco-feminism, the economy of commons, and social entrepreneurship. She is the leader of the hip-hop band KOMPOST. In April 2021 she was included in the Forbes Women ranking of 20 sustainable development leaders.



Krzysztof Brzózka

Chief Scientific Officer, EVP at Ryvu Therapeutics

Krzysztof Brzózka is the Chief Scientific Officer at Ryvu Therapeutics. He has joined Ryvu Theraputics in 2007 and has applied his interdisciplinary expertise ever since, to build a broad pipeline of small molecule oncology therapeutics and a high throughput discovery engine platform. Dr. Brzózka is responsible for the manage-

ment of the early pipeline candidates, covering their full development until the clinical phase. He is also responsible for bringing into the clinic two Ryvu first-in-class oncology programs: dual PIM/FLT3 inhibitor SEL24/MEN1703 and SEL120, CDK8 inhibitor. Dr. Brzózka is also a member of the board of Ardigen, a bioinformatics and precision medicine company, and contributed to the founding of NodThera, a biotechnology company focused on therapeutics related to inflammasome biology.

Krzysztof Brzózka holds a Ph.D. degree from Ludwig Maximilian University. He also earned an MBA from the Stockholm University School of Business and the Krakow University of Economics Business School. Dr. Brzózka contributed to over 20 peer-reviewed publications in areas including intracellular signaling, immunology, and medicinal chemistry.

His current research projects include climate change denialism online, anti-vaxxer internet communities, and bot detection. He serves on the Wikimedia Foundation Board of Trustees. He also founded and led several teched startups, including ling.pl, the largest online dictionary in Poland, and instaling.pl, a free educational platform for teachers, used by over 200 thousand users weekly.



Joanna Kalinowska

Development Director at the Copernicus Science Center

I am the Director of Development in the Copernicus Science Center. I graduated from Inter-Faculty Studies in Environmental Protection at Warsaw University and started my career working in the Polish Society for the Protection of Birds. I worked there for five years as the Project Coordinator and Director of Development before

joining the Copernicus Science Centre team before its opening. I have collaborated with all the CSC sponsors in joint events and activities ever since. My earlier professional experience in the field of fundraising resulted in setting up the Copernicus Club membership program for the Centre's regular visitors, and further in creating a new fundraising strategy for the museum. I was a member of the Programme Committee of the European network of science centers and museums (Ecsite) annual conference (2013 - 2019), and now I am the Chair of the Programme Committee for the Polish network of science centers and museums (SPiN) annual conference.

His recent research focuses on the effects of tsunamis and storms on paraglacial coastal environments of Arctic and sub-Arctic regions and prediction which sites are most vulnerable to their impacts in a warmer future. His ambition is to transfer new knowledge to help Arctic communities reduce the geohazard risk as most of their activities are concentrated along the coast. He is also the initiator of the Alfred Jahn Cold Region Research Programme at the University of Wroclaw designed to strengthen excellence in permafrost and periglacial research in Poland.


